
TWENTY-EIGHTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

"Jesus, Master, Have pity on us!"...Jesus said in reply, 'ten were cleansed, were they not? Where are the other nine? Has none but this foreigner returned to give thanks to God?' Then he said to him, 'Stand up and go, your faith has saved you.'... "But the word of God is not chained."

sion and assistance and not judgement. May we be supported in our Seen half sith and understand more clearly what the Lord is calling us to do.









Please take note of the following changes to our Mass schedule:


- Sunday, October 12: There will be no 5:00 PM Mass due to a priest convocation.
