MOUNTAIN TOP



A Franciscan monk was assigned to be a guide and “gofer” to Mother Teresa as she visited South Wales. He was thrilled at the prospect of being so close to this great and holy person. What would they talk about during the many hours they would spend together? Yet as the visit unfolded, he became frustrated—although he was constantly near her, he never had an opportunity to speak more than a few words to her— and then always about practical matters. There were always so many people around her. Finally when her tour was over and she was due to fly to New Guinea, in desperation the friar approached her and pleaded, “If I pay my own fare, could I sit next to you on the plane so I can talk with you more and learn from you?” Mother Teresa responded, “You have enough money to pay airfare to New Guinea?” “Yes” he replied eagerly. She replied, “Then give that money to the poor’ you’ll learn more from that than anything I can tell you.”

Jesus took Peter, James, and John and led them up a high mountain, “and he was transfigured before them. His face shone like the sun and his clothes became white as light.” Peter was overcome with excitement and awe. He wanted to pitch tents and prolong this moment as long as possible. But Jesus led them back down the mountain, where real life is lived, where we are called to live out the Gospel.

We’ve all had “mountain top” experiences— times in which we felt great peace and joy. Most likely we hoped that they would last forever, but they can’t, for this is not where real life is lived. On earth we are called to fulfill our Christian vocation. Our Lord needs us to be his hands and feet on the earth. He needs us to be another Christ for others. We can do it and there is no need to be afraid, because our Lord is with us every step of the way.

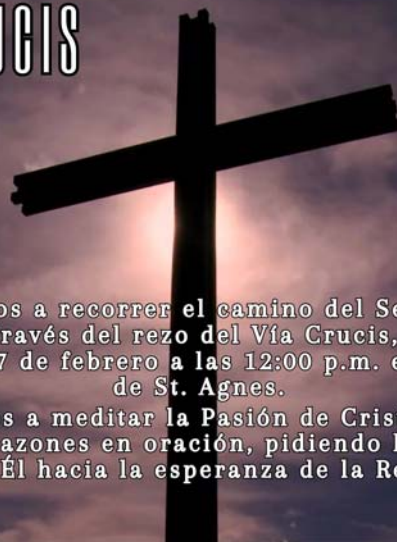
