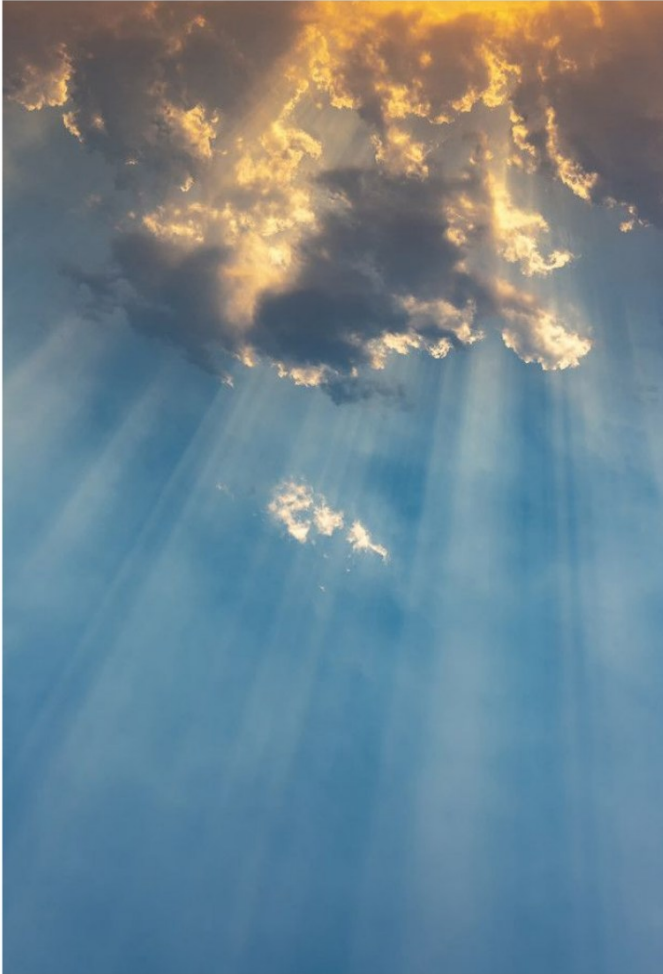

WHERE ARE YOU GOD?



“Is the Lord in our midst or not?” This question that the Israelites ask at the end of their episode in the desert is certainly a heartfelt one. What drove them to question God’s presence? It was probably a number of things. It certainly could have been their thirst under the hot desert sun. It could have also been their uncertainty about their future and their longing for the security of the life they knew in Egypt. In other words, Moses led them from their homes with the hope of the Promised Land, but they found themselves in a wasteland suffering from hunger and thirst. Surely, they must have felt that they had gone from the frying pan and into the fire.

“Is the Lord in our midst or not?” Isn’t this a question or feeling we’ve all had? All we need to do is turn on the news and feel this way. At times it seems that no matter in which direction we look we see great sickness, disasters, suffering and horrors. The question is if God is present in human suffering, then where is the sign of his presence?

Moses took this same question and concern to God and God’s response to Moses was for Moses to take action. He told Moses to strike a rock with his staff, and in this way God’s presence would be made known. Moses followed God’s instruction and suddenly a spring of life-giving water gushed from the rock.

The point is God’s presence is made known in times of great suffering through the efforts and goodness of others. God wants to use us to answer the cries of His children. As Christians we cannot sit on our hands and vaguely hope for answers to the world’s troubles and trials. Our world needs more people willing to strike the rock- to not only pray but to take action. Then others will know that indeed, God is in our midst.

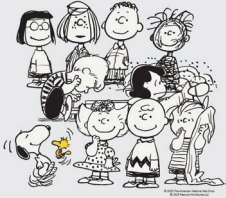
