I WAS BLIND, BUT NOW I SEE

Words From Our
Pastor

Some of us are farsighted- that is we have no trouble seeing things from a distance but cannot read the words of our hymnal without glasses or contacts. On the other hand, some of us are nearsighted- that is we can easily read the words of our hymnal, yet without glasses or contacts cannot clearly see me from the back pew of our church (although this can have something to do with my height as well).

As frail and imperfect as our bodily eyes can be, so too can our "spiritual eyes" be. Some can easily see the faults in others and yet have a very hard time seeing what their own faults are. On the other hand, some can see endless faults in themselves and yet only the good in others.

The Pharisees in our Gospel were spiritually blind to their own faults. Their refusal to accept the testimony of the man born blind (that it was Jesus who healed him), revealed their blindness. The irony is the man who had sight for only a few hours could see that Jesus was truly someone special, whereas the Pharisees remained unmoved by the miracle of Jesus. What would it have taken for them to realize their blindness or the truth? Or better yet, what will it take for us?

Our Gospel today encourages us to be aware of our own blindness. We are all imperfect; we all sin. Lent is the time for us to become aware of our own sinfulness, to repent, and do all we can to change. In Lent we are called to leave our sins with the ashes we received on Ash Wednesday and rise to new life with Christ. Like the blind man, may we too utter that heartfelt cry, "I was blind, but now I see!"

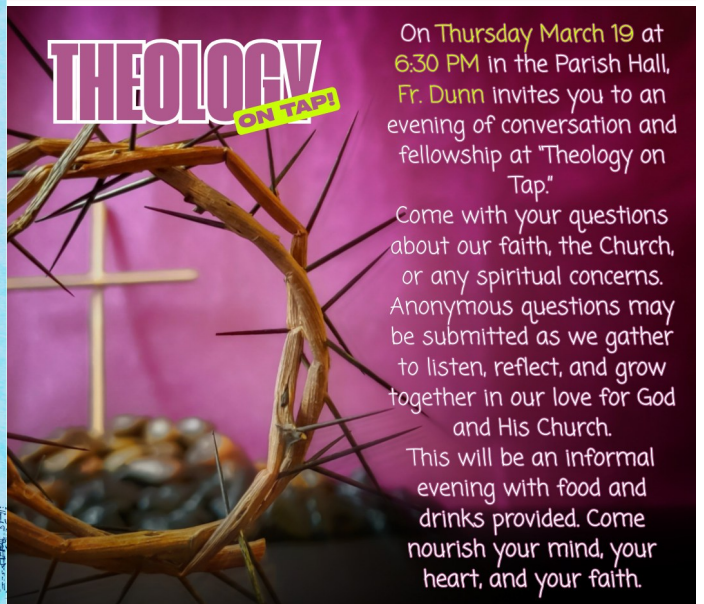


THEOLOGY ON TAP!

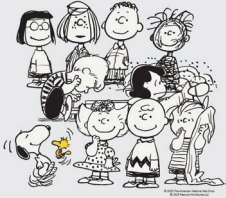
PARISH PARTNERS MINISTRY OF HOPE OFFERS:
