TOUGH LOVE

Words From Our
Pastor

Every good parent knows the importance and value of “tough love”, or doing what is best for one’s children no matter how much it hurts them. Such love is not easy, but real love is often hard and can be tiresome. The point is, when we go through hard times, or when life gets hard, perhaps it would be helpful to see God as our loving parent, who sometimes uses “tough love” with us His children. That is when one fails to get the job they wanted, when one’s affection and love are rejected by another, or when one experiences illness or injury, perhaps this may very well be God’s love at work. In other words, God may be guiding us, protecting or saving us from someone or something, or teaching us something important. The point is God loves us, his children, enough to say “No”. God our Father does what is best for his children, despite it being painful at times, so that his children may experience a greater and more lasting joy and happiness.

There is no escape from the cross, or a way to avoid suffering and trials in this world. Those with faith carry the same crosses that those without faith carry, for Scripture tells us that God rains on the just and the unjust, the good and the bad. But our sufferings and trials have value; they could work far better for us in the long run than any blessing. Those who take up their cross and follow Christ, will have their cross turned into a source of victory and joy. In other words, to be a disciple of Christ is to carry the unique potential and challenge that God assigns each of us. We cannot know the full mystery of our cross, but God will give us the strength to carry it. In our cross lies our own personal road to holiness and happiness.

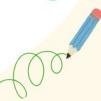

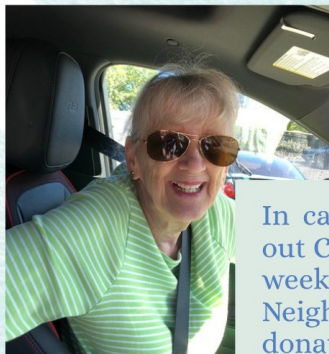

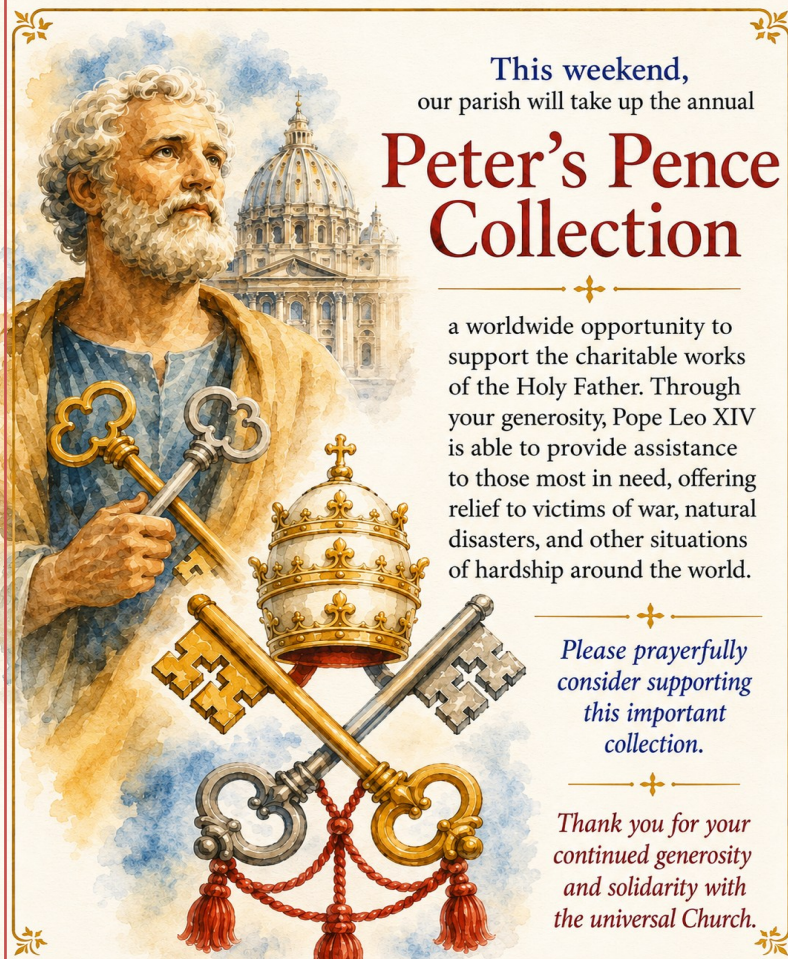
Your kindness is a tangible sign of God's love at work in our community and brings hope to those in need.
